AegeanMode HQ is located in Kastella,

5' from Neo Faliro station on Athens Metro Line 1, 1hr 5' from Athens International Airport, 30' from Athens Syntagma Square, 25' from Acropolis of Athens and 10' from Pireas Port and Mikrolimano Port.

From Athens International Airport Metro or Taxi transfer is suggested. In case of Metro embark Line 3 and change at Monastiraki Station to Line 1 to reach Neo Faliro Station. You can find a taxi right outside the station or walk to Megalou Alexandrou 15 Kastella.

From Athens Syntagma square or Acropolis Metro is suggested -Line 3 and change at Monastiraki Station to Line 1 to reach Neo Faliro Station. You can find a taxi right outside the station or walk to Megaloy Alexandrou 15 Kastella. **From Piraeus Port Metro is suggested** – board Line 1 to reach Neo Faliro Station. You can find a taxi right outside the station or walk to Megalou Alexandroy 15 Kastella.





The SRC / VHF course is a one day shore based course followed by an assessment which takes between 30min and 1 hour.

Participating on our VHF course (including GMDSS) requires some pre-course studying from your side. Once you book your place on the course we will send you the VHF RADIO (including GMDSS) Course Handbook G31 to read.

This pre-course reading (approx 3 hours) is vital. Focus on studying and understanding the topics from the VHF Handbook below, which will make the practical classroom course easier for you and will give you time to focus on the practical aspects of the course

The classroom SRC/VHF radio course and assessment starts at 09.00 and will end at approximately at 18.00.


